



2022 Competition regulations EcoTrail Al Ula, KSA

1. The 2nd edition of EcoTrail Al Ula will take place on Friday, 18 March and Saturday, 19 March 2022 and is open to runners in good physical and mental condition. Every single participant is required to register for one of the various race categories in advance of the event. For conditions of entry, please see the relevant section of this website. By registering, participants exempt the event organisers from any liability, whether civil or criminal, for damage to persons and/or property caused by or to them.

Restrictions :

From 20 years old for the 80km & 50km

From 18 years old for the 25km

From 12 years old for the 10km race & Sunset Run

Between 6 and 12 years old for the children's race2.

Each participant must read through the full event regulations and guidelines and is deemed to accept them when starting the race.

3. Participants should collect their participant race packs including number bibs, e-chip and GPS tracker (for 80K, 50K and 25K) at the Race Office on the day before the event. Number bibs are to be worn in front according to instructions given, and should not be bent or modified in any way. Participants not wearing any number bib will not be allowed to enter the starting area.

4. Participants should check-in at the start area at least 15 minutes before the announced start time of their chosen race

5. Only leg power is allowed. Any kind of automatic or mechanic aids are prohibited.

6. All participants should always behave in a sporting manner and shall permit any faster runner to overtake without obstructing.

7. All participants are required to help others who find themselves in an emergency, even if it comes at the expense of a good race result.

8. All participants must present the mandatory gear items (see list) for their chosen race distance when collecting their race pack. Failure to present an item = no race pack. During the race, participants must carry these mandatory gear items. Random checks by event staff can be conducted. Failure to present an item will result in a time penalty of 1 hour. Failure to present 2 items will result in disqualification from the race result.

The race is intended to be completed in a self-sufficiency manner. On the course will there be service areas where refreshments will be served. Drinks and food are to be consumed on the spot. Only water (excluding other drinks) can be filled up in flasks and containers.

Each runner must make sure to have sufficient food and water to reach to the next service point.

9. Participants in the 80K, 50K and 25K race categories can make use of the clothes deposit but are advised to avoid leaving objects of value in the bags; in any case the event organisation cannot be held responsible for theft, loss or damage to bags or their contents.

10. The running courses will be clearly marked by coloured arrows, flags and ribbons. The 80K = red, the 50K = orange, the 25K = purple and the 10K = blue. The Kid's race = yellow, the Sunset Run = turquoise.

11. The course of the 50k and 25K overlaps to a large extent the course of the 80k. Participants are required to follow the relevant markings at all times. Markings overrule GPS files (!). Lastminute amendments by the event organiser to the course may always occur for security or other reasons.

12. Participants who deliberately short-cut the race course will be disqualified from the race result.

13. A leading car with the race director for way-clearing, an ambulance, pick-up car for participants who abandon the race, and media cars are allowed on the race courses during the event. Besides those, no cars are allowed on the off-road race course.

14. There will be a few road crossings during the 80K, 50K, 25K and Sunset Run races. Follow the instructions of the event marshals when crossing those roads, and obey standard traffic regulations while running along roads.

15. Aid stations will be placed at approx. 10 km intervals for 80K, 50K and 25K, plus a last one with 5k to go. The 10K has one aid stations at km 4.5. The contents of these aid stations are described in the race details. Participants are permitted to have their own personal assistance crew, but only at these aid stations. Personal assistance outside the official aid stations will result in disqualification of the runner.

16. Participants who wish to stop their race and are able to do so are recommended to reach the next aid station. If you cannot continue to reach the next station, please call the emergency number printed on your number bib in case of genuine emergency indicating your approximate location, if possible using your GPS on your smartphone (mandatory item). In case of no emergency, please text the number indicating your approximate location, bib number and the words “DNF, request pick-up”. There will be dedicated DNF Busses, please understand that these might need a while to reach your location

17. Littering: EcoTrail does not tolerate any type of littering during the event. Participants who are spotted throwing away their bottles, cups, wrapping paper or any other garbage will be disqualified from the result list of the event.

18. Cut-off times. Each race category has a number of cut-off times that will be applied at aid stations and at the finish. The official cut-off times will be communicated as soon as the race courses are 100% finalised. The maximum time limit for the 80K race cannot exceed 12,5 hours (6:00 am to 18:30 pm).

19. A prize giving ceremony will be held after the races. Participants eligible for a prize are required to check the event timetable and remain at the Event Arena at Hegra to collect their prize on the podium stage.

20. Each finishing participant will receive an official certificate and finisher medal

21. Complaints about the race result can be communicated to the race jury until maximum 30 minutes after a runner’s personal finish time. Please note that a deposit of EUR 20 (or equivalent in other currency) will be required for the jury to handle the case. If the complaint is deemed justified by the race jury, the person who filed the complaint will get the deposit back.

22. The race jury is authorized to dismiss participants (results included) who have violated the race regulations, or have harmed the integrity of the event or of other participants.

23. The event organisation is authorized to shorten the race distances or cancel the event for security reasons or any case of force majeure.

24. EcoTrail follows the World Anti-Doping Code by WADA. Should testing by a legitimate antidoping body occur at the event, the selected participants will be required to comply with the testing officials’ procedures and demands. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the race.

25. The final authority on the interpretation of the regulations for all relevant races is owned by the race director supported by the race jury.

26. In taking part in the race, each competitor expressly authorises the EcoTrail AIUla (or its assignees) to use and allow to use or to reproduce or allow reproduction of their name, their image, their voice and their sports performance in the context of the race with regard to any direct exploitation or in the form derived from the event and this, in any support, in the whole world, through all known and unknown means to-date, and for the entire duration at present

granted to these direct or derived exploitations by the legislative or regulatory dispositions, legal or arbitrary decisions of the whole country as well by international agreements, current or future, allowing for possible extensions which might be made to this duration.

* regulations as of 15 October 2021. Minor amendments might be made closer to the event date.

GDPR Compliance

Article 1: Protection of personal data

RUN FOR YOU adheres to the protection of personal data and is committed to ensuring the security and confidentiality of personal data in compliance with EU regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 for the protection of natural persons regarding the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data (hereinafter “GDPR”), particularly by taking all the necessary precautions to prevent the distortion and damaging of such data and to prevent unauthorized third parties from accessing them.

When registering to a sporting event organized by RUN FOR YOU, the client is informed and agrees that their personal data are going to be:

- (i) collected on the website NJUKO owned by RUN FOR YOU
- (ii) processed by RUN FOR YOU as the entity responsible for the processing in accordance with the GDPR and by NJUKO as its subcontractor.

1.1 Identity of the entity responsible for the processing

Your personal data are collected by RUN FOR YOU, SARL (“Company with limited liability”) or simplified joint-stock company) registered under the unique identification number 513 851 246 RCS Nanterre and headquartered at 15, sentier des tricots, 92130 Issy-les-Moulineaux, with contact email: contact@runforyou.fr

1.2 Collected data and information

The data we collect are:

- ① Data required for the registration to a sporting event organized by RUN FOR YOU:

Upon registration, you will need to provide mandatory information identified by an asterisk on the website: last name, first name, birth date, gender, nationality, email address, mobile phone number, mailing address, language, information of the person to contact in case of

incident during a race (last name, first name, phone number), jersey size, medical certificate for competition capability.

This list may change depending on the legal, technical or organizational constraints from RUN FOR YOU.

② Optional data:

Upon registration, you will have the possibility to provide other data that are not mandatory to your registration (name of your club, landline phone number etc.).

Moreover, RUN FOR YOU may ask you to answer to one or several satisfaction surveys after the sporting event, which may lead us to collect additional data, such as: level of sport practice, consumption habits, socio-professional category, hobbies, events attendance, equipment used etc.

③ Data regarding payment:

Upon registration, banking service provider will collect and process data regarding your payment method (credit card number, expiration date and visual cryptogram (not kept) etc.). The data provided with your payment method upon registration are encrypted by a security system and remain encrypted when they are moved around network. banking service provider never shares the data regarding your payment method with us.

④ Technical data:

We may collect some technical data, such as your connection data and IP address, in compliance with the applicable legislation, to use various technologies such as Cookies if need be, and only with your agreement.

No sensitive data, such as information regarding racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, philosophical or religious beliefs, union membership etc., will be collected (article 9 of the GDPR).

1.3 Processing purposes

RUN FOR YOU processes and uses your personal data in order to:

- Manage and validate registrations to sporting events organized by RUN FOR YOU,
- Manage the provision of information to the participant via email and/or text message regarding the event they registered to (confirmation of the reception of the registration request, confirmation of the validation or rejection of the registration, information regarding the sporting event, information regarding the results etc.).
- Send satisfaction surveys produced for scientific and statistical purposes (through polls and questionnaires);
- Produce statistical surveys;

- Provide information regarding the offers and activities of RUN FOR YOU and related types of services.
- Send emails or text messages to inform you about sporting events organized by RUN FOR YOU or by a third party organizer that may interest you.
- Share data with our preferred partners (industrial, media, institutional) for promotional offers, advertising or any other form of commercial communication (subject to prior agreement from you when required and always respecting your right of opposition, in compliance with the applicable regulation regarding commercial prospectation).

1.4 Data storage

Your data is stored during the required period of time depending on the purposes previously mentioned.

Your data will be deleted if you do not answer to any of our solicitations for three years. However, we may store your data over a longer period of time in order to comply with our legal and regulatory obligations or in order to resolve disputes.

1.5 Data recipients

Personal data collected upon online registration may be communicated to:

- internal services of RUN FOR YOU (administrative staff, employees and other officers);
- Service providers and contractual partners of RUN FOR YOU that directly operate in the management of registrations and in the organization of the sporting event (timekeeper, bib maker, company in charge of medical assistance etc.);
- Preferred partners of RUN FOR YOU (industrial, media, institutional), with your agreement only, in order to offer products and/or services, or with commercial prospectation and/or advertising communication purposes.

RUN FOR YOU requires its service providers and partners to implement strict confidentiality and data protection methods.

If you explicitly agreed to it during the registration process by clicking the corresponding box, you may receive phone calls, mail, emails or text messages with promotional offers from our business partners that your data may be shared with and supplied to. Either way, you can use your right of opposition at any time, under the conditions specified hereinafter.

By choosing to take part in the sporting event, participants recognize and agree that:

- Their first and last name appear on the official starting list published on the website [https:// ecotrail.com](https://ecotrail.com);

□ after the sporting event, information regarding their sporting performance (including results, pictures and videos) be published on the website www.ecotrail.com, said results being liable to be used by any media.

If you wish to oppose such publication for a legitimate reason, you must communicate your decision in writing to our subcontractor at the following address: RUN FOR YOU – Traitement des données personnelles EcoTrail Challenge – 15 sentier des Tricots – 92130 Issy les Moulineaux, one month after the sporting event at the latest, so that appropriate measures can be taken.

Outside the conditions specified hereinabove, RUN FOR YOU commits not to use your personal data for selling, renting and supplying purposes, or to grant access to your data to a third party, without prior agreement from you, unless being forced to for a legitimate reason (legal obligation, fight against fraud, application of defense rights etc.).

Some of the recipients mentioned hereinabove may be established outside the European Union and be granted access to all or part of your personal information collected by RUN FOR YOU.

You explicitly agree that your data may be transferred to service providers or partners outside the European Union.

Within this framework, RUN FOR YOU commits to ensuring the protection of your data in compliance with the strictest rules, including the case-by-case signing of contractual clauses based on the template provided by the European Commission, or any other mechanism in compliance with the GDPR, as soon as your personal data begin to be processed by a service provider located outside the European Economic Area and which country is not considered by the European Commission as providing an appropriate level of protection.

1.6 Commercial offers

RUN FOR YOU may send you, via mail, emails, text messages or phone calls, information about their offers and services related to those you already purchased, which you recognize and agree to.

You have the right to oppose these commercial prospecting solicitations at any time and for free, under the conditions specified hereinafter.

1.7 Rights of the concerned person

In compliance with the terms laid out in the revised version of the French Data Protection Act of 6 January 1978, and the GDPR, the persons concerned by the processed personal data have a right of access, rectification and deletion of the data concerning them, as well as a right of limitation and opposition to the processing and moving of their personal data. They also have a right of opposition to the processing of their personal data for commercial prospecting purposes from RUN FOR YOU and/or its partners.

Pursuant to Article 12.6 of the GDPR, RUN FOR YOU can, in case of reasonable doubt concerning the identity of the natural person making the request, ask for additional information in order to confirm the identity of this person.

Pursuant to Article 12.3 of the GDPR, RUN FOR YOU commits to providing the information on the measures taken after a request concerning the above-mentioned rights as soon as practicable and at all events, within a one month period as of the day of reception of the request.

If you do not/no longer want to receive our offers, solicitations or newsletters, you are also able to let us know by clicking the unsubscribe link at the bottom of each communication.

If you do not want to receive newsletters, invitations or promotional offers from our partners, you are also able to let us know during registration by clicking the corresponding box.

Please note that you can sign up to the “Bloctel” call blocking list if you do not want to receive promotional phone calls (<https://www.bloctel.gouv.fr/>).
